Bayside Kangaroos Orienteering Club Inc Driving Directions to our Foot O Bush Maps

Barambogie North and South (North East Fire Ban District)

Melway 922 E7 VicRoads 35 B5

Take the Hume Freeway (M31) to Chiltern exit (about 3.5 to 4 hours from Melbourne) There are three logical assembly areas on both these maps, two must be approached from the east side and one from the west side.

The main track that crosses the map (east side to west side) is not suitable for most vehicles just going to assembly area.

East side assembly area is at northern quarry or in pine forest

From Chiltern exit take Beechworth Road 3km to Eldorado turn off. Turn then 500metre to Barambogie Road turn left then 4km to quarry area

Western side assembly area is on south western corner of the map

From Melbourne take Old Cemetery Road off Hume Freeway (M31) 4km **before** the Chiltern exit. Follow O signs south along western edge of map

Butterfly Gully and Jim Crow (Central Fire Ban District)

Melway 909 C9 VicRoads 59 C7

On Butterfly Gully there are two main assembly areas. One is at a farmers paddock near the west side of the map (permission is required to use the area).

The other is at a group of track junctions on the east side of the map. This is on the left side off Basalt Road. This is about 2km past Werona Road

From centre of Daylesford take Midlands Highway south west towards Eganstown and Ballarat

After 5km turn right onto Basalt Road. After 3km veer left onto Werona Road. Then allow 10 to 15 minutes to get the farmers paddock assembly area.

Jim Crow assembly area is in another farmers paddock (permission required) which fronts onto Werona Road. This is the northern of the two farmers' paddocks.

Musk Vale (Central Fire Ban District)

Melway 909 D10 Vic Roads 59 D7

There are two logical assembly areas on this map.

First is at Lake Jubilee itself. Public toilets are there

From Daylesford/Ballan Road follow signs to Lake Jubilee Caravan Park. This is adjacent to the lake.

Walk 500 metres south across the road and assemble at the top of the hill next to the cutting

Second assembly area is near southern end of map. Continue past Lake Jubilee Caravan Park. Turn right at four way intersection and park near the dam.

Sailors Creek (Central Fire Ban District)

Melway 909 C10 VicRoads 59 C8

There are two main assembly areas on this map. One is on the southern side off Telegraph Road. The other is on the western side along Bells Reef Road.

From centre of Daylesford take Daylesford/Ballan Road 8km past Musk Vale and turn right onto Telegraph Road at the Sailors Falls rest area.

Travel 1km and turn into forest track. CAUTION cannot easily see other traffic.

From centre of Daylesford take Midlands Highway south west towards Eganstown and Ballarat. After 4km turn sharp left into Bells Reef Road

Franklin Gorge (North Central Fire Ban District)

Melway 909 C8 VicRoads 59 D5

Take Midlands Highway from Daylesford towards Castlemaine.

Travel past Mount Franklin and the Newstead turnoff

Turn right at Limestone track. Travel slowly so you do not disturb the emu farm.

Irishtown and Deadman's Flat (North Central Fire Ban District)

Melway 909 D7 VicRoads 59 E4

Take the Calder Highway and take the Malmsbury exit

Turn left at C316 toward Daylesford.

After 4.0 km turn right at Vaughan Springs Road.

Travel 18.0km to road junction on Irishtown map.

From Campbell's Creek travel 7.5km towards Fryerstown, turn right 1.0km to road junction.

Bostock (Central Fire Ban District) Melway 909 D12 Vic Roads 77 D3

Take Western Highway toward Ballarat

Take Ballan/Daylesford exit and turn south

Cross the railway line and then take Shaws Road next right towards the reservoir

Mount Hickey (North Central Fire Ban District) Melway 910 N7 Vic Roads 61 D4

Take Hume Freeway (M31) north past the Broadford exit.

After 9km turn right at Ennis Road. This is about one hour from the Melbourne Ring Road Take extreme care crossing divided highway.

Travel 15km along Ennis Road to assembly areas.
